



CAPTURING ESSENCE

Yitzhak Dalal's Artistic Evolution in the World of Photography

Can you share the story of how you decided to join the Israeli Air Force at 18 and how that experience led you to pursue a career in photography?

Serving in the Israeli army is mandatory for all men at 18 years old. As a kid I was always fascinated by airplanes. I considered myself lucky to be sent into the Israeli Airforce where I was given two options: either to be a missile launcher or to be a photographer. I was fortunate to have the choice of being a photographer and always felt this was my calling.

What motivated you to attend the Brooks Institute of Photography, and how did majoring in Illustration influence your photography style?

Watching movies as a teenager, I was fascinated by America and the American lifestyle. I looked at photography schools on the West Coast and knew Brooks Institute was the most suitable for me. Majoring in Fashion and Illustration was a great foundation, carving out a style both classic, yet contemporary.

My style was refined by assisting leading fashion photographers in NYC. And ultimately, my style continues to evolve to this day.

After graduating in 1978, you worked as an assistant to fashion photographers in NYC. How did that experience shape your understanding of the industry, especially working with publications like Vogue, Bazar, and Elle?

By witnessing how fashion shoots were orchestrated at major magazines, I gained confidence in my own talent and capabilities. But your talent can only get you so far; It's a team effort! Definitely networking, having a supportive agent, and working with the right group of talented individuals propels you forward.

What prompted your decision to move to Israel and work as a fashion and advertising photographer for two years? What insights did you gain from the Israeli market?

I moved to New York City assisting fashion photographers (hard jobs to get) and ran out of money. So I had no option but to move back home to Israel and be closer to my family. I worked in Israel for 2 years as a fashion and advertising photographer, and did really well. But the market was

too small at the time and I was ready for a bigger challenge. I managed to save up enough money to go back to the US.

After your time in Israel, you moved back to the US. What challenges or opportunities did you encounter upon your return, and how did this period contribute to your growth as a photographer?

Making a living in fashion was difficult in the beginning (even though I had shot a billboard and some catalogs). So I decided to apply my knowledge in fashion & fine arts to wedding photography. And through this I brought a fresh look to the way wedding photography was done in Los Angeles.

Your experience in wedding photography taught you to be aware and adapt to changing situations. Can you share a specific instance where this skill proved crucial in your work, especially in the transition to fashion photography?

I learned to work in the moment and make

the best of what I have. For instance, while shooting a high fashion story in Downtown LA, I noticed a young man walking down the street with a cute dog. I saw the potential for a great shot and immediately asked the owner's permission to include his dog in the shoot.

In 1996, you had a series of abstract photographs featured at LACMA's Art Rental Gallery. Can you delve into the inspiration behind that series?

I always go back to my first art class which taught me how to see photography as a language. As much as I love editorial work and working with people, I enjoy the therapeutic process of discovering beauty in the simplest things around us. It's a constant journey.

Being on the cover of Professional Photographer of America in 2006 is a significant achievement. How did that recognition influence your career, and how have you adapted to industry changes since then?

It was very rewarding to be chosen for the interview, let alone, be on the cover. It was one moment in a long career of moments that encouraged me to continue and push forward.

"There is no ego in my work"



You mentioned enjoying working with people and bringing out the best in them. How do you establish a connection with your subjects, and how does this connection enhance the final outcome of your photographs?

There is no ego in my work. It is purely genuine. I always try to make people feel comfortable, while being myself, and connecting with others. The most important step is gaining their trust and making them feel at home. Once trust is gained, your subject wants to contribute and be a part of the journey with you.

What aspects of the creative process do you find most fulfilling when creating new images, and are there specific themes or concepts you gravitate towards in your recent work?

I am very passionate about photography, almost to an obsession. I always enjoy looking at new images, as much as I enjoy creating them. I am constantly seeking inspiration and gaining awareness of what's current. Small details can ignite my imagination. I strive for simplicity and elegance throughout my work.

Lastly, you expressed a desire to shoot editorials for major magazines. What attracts you to editorial photography, and are there specific publications you aspire to collaborate with?

What I like about editorial photography is the freedom of expression in telling a visual story. The ultimate recognition is shooting for high-end magazines like Vogue, Bazaar, or Elle.
