MODELING, MOTION, AND MUSCLE

A Decade-Long Adventure with Katie Laura Burnett

Insights into a Diverse Career

Can you share more about your 12-year journey as a model and your decision to transition from engineering to dancing and sports massage therapy?

My modelling started out at events such as motorcross, car shows, and boxing events. This quickly developed into promotional work and then i was asked to shoot for photographers. I started doing paid casting calls, and it's progressed from there. I have continued modelling alongside my other jobs. I moved to dancing to leave engineering as there was no progression made available for me. I'm very adaptable. If you enjoy something and put your heart and soul into it, you'll never produce bad work.

My sports massage therapist business is better than i ever thought it would be. I have my own space to work in, it's so therapeutic. Even though the techniques aren't always pain free, it makes the clients feel great after and i love helping people wether thats with their goals, training, or just to de-stress from everyday life.

Congratulations on your recent achievement in the bikini bodybuilding competition! How did you prepare for it, and what motivated you to enter the competition at 34 for the first time?

Thank you! I decided to take part in a First Timers PCA show 8 weeks before their last competition date of 2023! I wanted to hold as much muscle as possible/ attempting to grow whilst cutting down. I practised posing every day and went through transitions... when i was doing cardio, at my other job and basically in my sleep.

I just thought if i dont do this now, i never will. So, i registered, dieted and trained, drove 5 hours up to Hull, got tanned twice and did it. I managed to place third and got an invite to PCA worlds. I am just so grateful for these opportunities.

Balancing modeling, dancing, and sports massage therapy seem quite dynamic. How do you manage these diverse professional roles, and do you find that each role complements the others in any way?

The modelling i have done since a young age, i have done this along side my other jobs. I love the creativity, the art, working with new people in new places, and sometimes travelling too! The dancing definitely keeps me fit, its a tiring job so it also teaches you patience on slow nights and perseverance staying up until 5am every shift in very different types of con-

ditions, this depends on the club. You can be artistic and elegant in these jobs, my stage sets show my personality or mood the most. The modelling definitely helped with expressing my emotion and visions. My sports massage therapy business is my main focus, i know so many people who train and compete and lets face it, who doesn't like a deep tissue massage!

I'm a very professional person, so i dont struggle jumping from role to role. The approach is the same - to be the best i can be at whatever i do.

You mentioned a desire to work with creative, like-minded people and create great art across various categories. Can you elaborate on your artistic vision in modeling and the types of projects you are particularly excited about?

I love creating images that i thought were impossible, by impossible i mean impossible for me to produce, to make, or to be part of. The more shoots you do, the harsher you critique yourself its the bitter sweet part of modelling. You know what you like, what you dont, how you want an image to speak about you or what you want it to say to the world.

I love surprising myself, its such a personal journey, i can't really explain it into words. I love classic black and white shoots best. When i was little I looked up to the work of women on bay watch, some models and the gladiators - some such as; Jet and Panther, Pamela Anderson, Carmen Electra, Donna D'Errico, Naomi Campbell, Kate Moss, etc.

Being featured in magazines such as Gothic Girl, Fuse, Skyn, and FHM UK is impressive. How do you think these experiences have contributed to your career, and what do you enjoy most about collaborating with publications?

In life, it's amazing to just have these opportunities presented. I grew up having idols that i thought were so different to me, my work sometimes makes me feel that the worlds not quite SO big, we're not all so alone and maybe we've shared some of the same dreams, feelings or emotions along the way.

To have my images accepted into magazines is always exciting. Every magazine or online interview gets seen or read by different people and thats whats important to me. Hopefully, i can give hope, an idea or strength to someone out there reading this, considering pursuing something, even a dream they may have had as a kid, just go and do it.

Looking forward, what are your aspirations in the modeling and dancing industry? Are there specific projects, collaborations, or goals you have set for yourself in the near future?

I am looking to do more photoshoots in 2024 as i progress with my physique and continue to sculpt into the best version of myself. With age im finding i have so much more clarity about how i want to look, what it takes to create that and the type of work in the modelling world that i will produce. I will work with existing and new photographers and hope to build on my portfolio creating some insane photographs and art along the way.

Given your background in fitness competitions, how do you integrate your passion for fitness into your modeling work? Are there specific themes or styles that you feel particularly drawn to in this regard?

Fitness modelling is now something i would like to pursue more of as i naturally fall into that category. I may do more bikini competitions in the future but i will decide if and when the times right when it presents itself. I feel if i were to do back-to-back shows i wouldn't be working on myself inbetween. That means 0 time to improve or grow as a person or time to create a better package to present.



A decent amount of time off shows dedication to the sport and understanding the honour it is to step on stage better than the previous time.




What advice would you give to individuals aspiring to pursue a career in modeling, especially those who may be interested in transitioning between different fields like you have done?

I would say that everyones journey in modelling is personal. Do what makes you happy and what your comfortable with. There are so many categories and fields to explore, from editorial to fashion to fitness etc.

I just do what comes naturally to me. Sometimes, one shot on set can produce a completely new idea, a new pose to try a new emotion or feeling this changes the photo completely, a good photographer will capture this.

The best pictures are the unplanned ones, the shots you dont pose for, in my opinion.
