LADYDIABOLIKA: A Decade of Glamour and Artistry with Christophe Mourthé

Can you share how your collaboration with Christophe Mourthé began and what makes this partnership so special?

First of all, I should say that I have always admired Christophe Mourthé's photographic style and his way of portraying a powerful, sensual, and free woman through his lens. I've always loved his attention to detail and his sophisticated Old Hollywood-inspired glamour, reminiscent of the divas of the past.

In 2010, while I was in Paris for an event, I learned about the presentation of Christophe Mourthé's biography, "La femme est un Art", which included a meet & greet with the artist. A mutual friend introduced us, and from that moment, we stayed in touch through social media, back then, it was Myspace. In 2014, we had our first opportunity to collaborate on an artistic project and it was fantastic!

The beauty of our very first collaboration was discovering that Christophe Mourthé and I shared a natural understanding on set, despite my rudimentary French. This is because we share a cultural background that naturally aligns our creative visions. This aspect is both unique and wonderfully magical.

What can you reveal about your upcoming fourth book? How does it differ from your previous three collector's editions?

We are currently preparing our fourth collector's photographic book, which will be released in 2025. I'm excited to share a preview of some of the photos that will be part of it. Each book features a curated collection of our best works, distinguished by the unique atmospheres and characters I embody under Christophe Mourthé's direction. Moreover, the books showcase works captured over different years, reflecting my artistic evolution over a 10-year timeframe. The first book covers the period from 2014 to 2018, marking the beginning of our collaboration. The second book collects images taken throughout 2022, while the third features a selection of photos created in 2023.

What is your creative process when working with Christophe Mourthé to bring his dreamlike vision to life?

When Christophe Mourthé and I dive into our creative process, it usually starts with inspiration from a book, a movie, or even a song from the past. We rarely over-plan; instead, we let ourselves be guided by the inspiration of the moment.

Whenever I travel to France to work with him, I bring an almost embarrassing number of outfits and accessories, many of which I've tailor-made myself, to

allow us the flexibility to bring our ideas to life. Christophe Mourthé also has an extensive collection of original vintage clothing and accessories. The magic happens when we combine our resources to create worlds that are often unexpected, even for us.

How has your career evolved since you began working as a stylist, make-up artist, and hair stylist in 2007?

I began my career by collaborating with various photographers to build my portfolio. Like many starting out, I experimented with different genres before finding my passion for glamour. I love creating images of sensual and sophisticated women, and even my tailoring naturally gravitates in that direction. I enjoy celebrating femininity and beauty in all their forms.

As a makeup artist and stylist, I'm also familiar with visual languages beyond glamour. Since 2007, I've gained substantial experience across various fields, including fashion, commercial photography, and video.

Currently, I work with photographers, fashion brands, filmmakers, and private clients. For about ten years, I was also the go-to stylist, makeup artist, and hair stylist for Nikon Italia's live events and photography workshops.

How do you approach creating sophisticated glamour shoots, and what do you think sets your work apart in this genre?

When creating a glamour shoot, I always start by understanding the client's style and needs, then consider how I can contribute with my own taste to create something truly special. Blending different influences often results in captivating shots, and I'm continually amazed by the creative synergies that emerge on set.

I believe my style reflects influences from my cultural background. While it may not appeal to everyone, I think it resonates with those who share a sensitivity similar to mine.

Can you tell us more about your custom-made outfit designs under Ladydiabolika? What inspires your creations?

My tailoring skills predate the creation of the Ladydiabolika brand. I learned the basics of sewing within my family, which allowed me to bring Ladydiabolika's custom outfits to life. Currently, these are limited-edition clothing and accessories created exclusively for my photo shoots and styling wardrobe. I replicate them only on commission, tailoring each piece to the client's specific measurements.

Inspiration for my designs often comes from the divas of the past, as well as iconic figures from cinema, photography, music, and entertainment.

How do your designs complement Christophe Mourthé's photography style? Could you share an example where this synergy truly shined?

My custom creations are designed for a confident, sensual, and free woman, a "femme fatale" who knows how to wield her powers of seduction. This is the type of woman who also inhabits Christophe Mourthé's dreamlike vision.

I've included images to illustrate the seamless union between my tailored designs and Christophe Mourthé's artistic vision.

What challenges have you faced in your artistic journey, and what do you find most rewarding about your work?

Life as a freelancer is not always easy, and it's easy to lose enthusiasm along the way. It's important to maintain a positive attitude and use free time to focus on creativity and professional growth.

Creating beauty is a great gift for me. When my work helps women feel beautiful and sensual, it's an immense source of satisfaction.

As you celebrate 10 years of collaboration with Christophe Mourthé, what milestones stand out for you?

Reflecting on these 10 years of artistic collaboration, I'm struck by the fact that we always find something new to create together photographically. We inspire each other always with new challenges and I'm deeply honored by the trust Christophe places in me, even when I assist him as a make-up artist and hair stylist on shoots with other models in his studio.

What advice would you give to aspiring stylists and designers who wish to work in glamour art photography?

My journey has been unconventional because, as a model, I've had the opportunity to bring my creations to life firsthand. My advice is to collaborate and experiment as much as possible in the beginning. This will help you understand the dynamics of the field and identify your direction.

This is a profession built on connections, so getting out there and creating them is essential.

How do you approach visual storytelling in your designs and photography collaborations?

For me, visual storytelling always begins with a dialogue to understand what we want to convey through a shoot. If there is a strong connection with the person you're working with, everything transforms into creative harmony. Speaking the same visual language makes it much easier to align and pursue the same vision.

Beyond the fourth book, what future projects are you excited about, and how do you see your artistic journey evolving?

This fourth collector's photography book with Christophe Mourthé, set to be released in the new year, represents a significant milestone for my creative work in 2024. It's amazing that, in a fast-paced world focused on fleeting content, we're creating something enduring and timeless. Beyond this, I'm pursuing exciting collaborations in Italy and exploring new creative opportunities. Who knows, perhaps even more exciting projects are on the horizon.



A VIBRANT REBELLION AGAINST MINIMALIST MAKEUP TRENDS






